2024 was a very impactful year for the Greater Peterborough Health Services Foundation (GPHSF). Through this Impact Report, we wanted to draw your attention to a few of the important initiatives we have been part of. Our impact in the Peterborough area is varied but substantial. We continue our mission of working with community partners, including the Peterborough Family Health Team, to support the evolving health needs of Peterborough City and County. PETERBOROUGH BUTTERFLY RUN

The 2024 Peterborough Butterfly Run carried the momentum of the return to a live run in 2023 into the new year. Over 1000 people came out to run in the event, with hundreds more coming to support them and cheer them on. Proceeds continue to support the development of bereavement kits for families and individuals who experience early and later pregnancy loss and infant loss. Over 800 such kits have now been developed. Proceeds also support educational opportunities, lending libraries and the continuation of the run as a supportive community building event. Over \$96,000 was raised this year. The 2025 run will be on April 27th.



TEBEY GOLF CLASSIC - YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH

The 2024 Tebey Golf Classic was another year of substantial growth and impact. Selling out within moments of going onsale helped us set a tournament record of over \$77,000 in revenue. Once again, the event supported youth mental health along with the services provided by YES Shelter for Youth and Families and Peterborough Youth Services. Through the support of our golfers, sponsors and donors we were able to give over \$17,000 to EACH of these organizations to support their youth mental health programming. We will be host the Tebey Golf Classic once again at Wildfire Golf Club in 2025.

SENIOR CARE MICRO GRANTS

In August of 2024 we announced our new Senior Care Micro Grant program. Two \$5000 grants were made available to support senior care projects and healthy aging initiatives in Peterborough City, County, Hiawatha First Nation and Curve Lake First Nation.

Our inaugural recipients are Community Care Peterborough and the Peterborough Family Health Team unattached patient's clinics.

Community Care Peterborough applied to address food insecurity in our senior population and provide funding for their Meals on Wheels program, along with grocery shopping and delivery supports. The Peterborough Family Health Team submitted for equipment to provide increased ease and access to care for our seniors who do not have a family doctor and are utilizing the one of the two Peterborough FHT unattached patient clinics.

These grants have been made possible due to funding provided by the June Towle Trust. June Towle passed away in 2023. As part of her legacy, she established the June Towle Trust that would see money from her estate be donated to the Greater Peterborough Health Services Foundation upon her passing. We greatly appreciate these legacy funds that June left to the Foundation and hope to honour June's memory through our micro grant program.

COMPASSION FUND

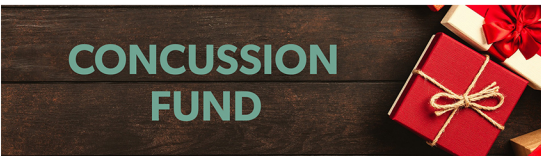
COMPASSION FUND

This funds directive is to support patients in health equity, providing such resources as blood pressure cuffs for home readings, fresh food boxes, assisting with medical supplies not covered by OHIP, providing transportation to medical appointments, among other needs. This

funding can be accessed by clinicians of the Peterborough Family Health Team to directly support their patients and address barriers to care that the patient may be encountering. This funding can be transformative for a patient's health outcome, providing equipment they may not be able to get otherwise, fresh food, or even just a ride to a very important medical appointment. It allows the clinicians to do more to support their patients.

DR. STEVE SENIOR MEMORIAL FUND

GPHSF was once again proud to present the keynote address at Brian FHT 2024. Brian FHT is an annual professional development day, provided by the Peterborough Family Health Team, for local medical professionals. Funding for this support came from the Dr. Steve Senior Memorial Fund for Continuing Education, which was established in 2013. It provides funding for educational events hosted by the Peterborough Family Health Team. Dr. Senior was passionate about providing continuing education opportunities for physicians and healthcare professionals in the Peterborough and surrounding area to help provide better care for their patients.

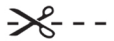


CONCUSSION FUND

GPHSF actively supports concussion education in our community, primarily through PACA (Peterborough Athletics Concussion Awareness) and the H.O.P.E Student Bursary in Honour of Steve Montador. We recently saw two large fundraising efforts take place.

GPHSF hosted the Toronto Maple Leafs vs Montreal Canadiens Alumni game at the Memorial Centre, with partial proceeds supporting the Concussion Fund. The fund was also the recipient of \$10,000 in funding from 100 Men Peterborough. Many resources have been developed and continue to be developed to raise awareness of what to do if a concussion is suspected, including the docu-series Recognize, Remove, Manage, Prevent.
